

## **JESUS IS AT WORK**

### **Hebrews 10:10-14**

#### **Introduction:**

Two weeks ago, Christians celebrated Easter – The death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ, according to the Scriptures. Jesus is Alive Forevermore! Have you given any thoughts to where Jesus is or what He has been doing for over 2,000 years, since He ascended to Heaven up until now? If not, let me tell you something, **Jesus is Alive and at Work!**

#### **Jesus is at the right hand of God in Heaven:**

- (Mark 16:19; Rom 8:34; Heb 10:12; Heb 12:2; Rev 3:21).

#### **I. Jesus is Alive Within Every Believer** (John 15:26; Rom 8:9-10)

Jesus dwells within every Believer, in the person of the Holy Spirit.

“<sup>1</sup>My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: <sup>2</sup>And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world” (1 John 1:1-2).

##### **A. Jesus is our advocate**

#### **IV. Jesus is Preparing a Place for us in Heaven** (John 14:1-3)

“<sup>1</sup>Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. <sup>2</sup>In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

<sup>3</sup>And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also (John 14:1-3).

#### **The Promises of Jesus about His Return:**

- A. “I go to prepare a place for you” (v. 2)
- B. “I will come again” (v. 3)
- C. “that where I am, there ye may be also” (v. 3)
