Introduction:

God has called us to be Holy in all we say, do and think. We are to "do all to the Glory of God" (1 Cor 10:31). Glory is to praise and honor God.

I. Preparing Our Minds for Action (v. 13a)

"Gird up the loins of your mind"

- A. This means to gather up all loose thoughts; to gird up your mind and thoughts.
- B. The Believers were suffering terrible persecution –

II. Exercising Self-Control (v. 13b)

- A. Things that can intoxicate our minds and render us useless in serving God.
- B. We must be spiritually alert and watchful
- C. Things that will hinder our relationship with God:
