Introduction:

- A. The Bible is **Inspired** (Record of truth by human authors)
- **B.** The Bible is **Inerrant** (The written Word of God without error)
- C. The Bible is <u>Infallible</u> (Completely Trustworthy)
- **D.** The Bible is <u>Authoritative</u> (Standard for Doctrine and Holy Living)
- E. The Bible is <u>Preserved</u> (The Word of God is safe, alive, intact, and free from decay)
- I. <u>The Word of God is "Quick"</u> (v. 12a)
 - A. The Word of God is not a dead and meaningless Book
 - **B.** It is an Inexhaustible Book
 - C. The Life of God's Word is due to the Nature of God Himself
- II. <u>The Word of God is "Powerful"</u> (v. 12b)
 - A. It has the power to save
 - **B.** It is through the Word of God that a Person is Born Again
 - C. It works effectively in those who believe
- III. <u>The Word of God is Sharp</u> (v. 12c)
 - A. "Sharper than any two-edged Sword"
 - B. The two-edged sword has two sharp edges that cuts in two directions.
- IV. <u>The Word of God is a Discerner</u> (v. 12d)
 - A. Its effects on man reveals his true heart.
 - B. A Christian cannot hear or read the Word of God without being affected

Conclusion:

A. The Bible, the Word of God, is Alive, Powerful, Sharp and a Discerner
