

THE GRACE OF GOD TITUS 2:11-14

Introduction:

Grace is God giving His greatest Heavenly treasure (Jesus Christ) to the least deserving – which is every one of us.

- I. The Grace of God Provides Salvation (v. 11)**

The Grace of God provides Salvation to man. God's Grace is Jesus Christ, the Gift of the Savior of the world.

 - A. The Grace of God is available to everyone** – God is able to Save.
 - B. The Grace of God is not Earned** – It is completely Unmerited and Undeserved
 - (Eph 2:8-9).
 - C. The Grace of God is Free**
 - (Rom 3:24)
 - D. Salvation means that the Christian has been:**

- II. The Grace of God Teaches Christian Living (v. 12)**

The Grace of God teaches Believers how to live.

 - A. The Grace of God teaches the negative side of Christian living** (What to Avoid).
 - B. The Grace of God teaches the positive side of Christian living** (What to Do)

- III. The Grace of God Gives Hope (v. 13)**

Grace provides the Believer with Hope. Hope is the confident expectation of what God has promised and its strength is in His faithfulness – God has/will fulfill His promises.

- IV. The Grace of God is Demonstrated in the Death of Jesus (v. 14)**
 - A. Jesus died to redeem us from all iniquity (lawlessness)**
 - B. Jesus died so that he might have a peculiar people**
 - C. Christ died so that we will be zealous of good works**

- V. The Grace of God is a Message to be Proclaimed (v. 15)**
 - A. We are to speak forth the Grace of God**
 - (John 3:16; 1 Tim 1:15).
 - B. We are to exhort (encourage) people in the grace of God**
 - C. We are to rebuke (reprove, convict, correct)**
 - (Rom 6:23).

Conclusion:

- A. Jesus is Coming Again! Are You Ready for His Return?**
- B. Grace, Grace, God's Grace; Grace that will pardon and cleanse within**
Grace, Grace, God's Grace; Grace that is greater than all our sins!
- C. "For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich" (2 Cor 8:9).**
- D. Romans Road (Rom 3:10, 23; 5:8; 10:9, 13)**
