## ONESIMUS: A MAN GREATLY TRANSFORMED BY CHRIST PHILEMON 8-25

- I. Paul's Appeal for Onesimus (vv. 8-9)
  - **A. Philemon was a wealthy slaveowner** as well as a godly Christian man.
  - B. Paul shared the Gospel with Onesimus who became a Christian.
  - C. At some point, Onesimus informed Paul that he was a runaway slave.
  - D. In this letter to Philemon, Paul asked Philemon to forgive Onesimus.
- **II.** The Conversion of Onesimus (vv. 10-11)
  - **A.** "My Son" (v. 10a) Paul served as Onesimus' spiritual faither, his mentor
  - **B.** "Begotten" (v. 10b) means born again Onesimus was a changed man.
  - C. Paul led Onesimus to Christ while he was in prison "in my bonds" (v. 10c)
  - **D.** Onesimus means Profitable/Useful (v. 11)
- **III.** The Restitution of Onesimus (vv. 12-14)
  - A. Paul sent Onesimus Back to Philemon (his master)
  - B. As a Christian, Philemon was to Right his Wrong
  - C. Onesimus was very dear to Paul
  - D. Paul wanted to keep Onesimus with him in Rome
  - E. Paul did not want to do anything without Philemon's wholehearted consent (v. 14)
- **IV.** The Restoration of Onesimus (vv. 15-16)
  - A. Paul asked Philemon to welcome Onesimus back as a Beloved Brother (v. 16)
  - B. Paul believed that the Providence of God was at Work
- V. The Brotherhood of Onesimus (vv. 17-21)
  - A. Paul urged Philemon to receive and trust Onesimus (vv. 16).
  - B. Paul asked Philemon to receive Onesimus as a Partner and Brother in the Ministry.
  - C. Paul informed Philemon that he would pay whatever money or goods Onesimus had stolen Paul told him: Put that on mine account" (v. 18).
  - D. Paul advised Philemon to always remember the debt he owed for his own Salvation.
  - E. Paul said he would be filled with joy in his heart if Philemon received Onesimus as a Partner and Brother in the Lord (v. 20)
  - F. Paul said he had great confidence that Philemon would honor his request and do more than he is asking for (v. 21)
  - G. "We are the Lord's Onesimus" Martin Luther
