## OUR CHRISTIAN DUTIES Colossians 4:2-6

# **Introduction:**

Based on our text for today, we will examine two commands for our Christian Duties: (1) "Continue in Prayer" and (2) Walk in Wisdom Toward Outsiders.

- I. <u>"Continue in Prayer"</u> (vv. 2-4)
  - A. Continue Steadfastly in Prayer (v. 2a)
  - **B.** Watch in Prayer (v. 2b)
  - C. Pray with Thanksgiving (v. 2c)
  - **D. Pray for Others** (vv. 3-4)
- II. <u>Walk in Wisdom Toward Outsiders</u> (vv. 5–6)
  - A. Believers are to walk wisely toward outsiders Unbelievers (v. 5a)
  - **B.** Believers are to walk wisely by "redeeming the time" (vv. 5b; 6c)
  - C. Believers are to have godly speech toward every one (v. 6)

## **Conclusion:**

- **A.** Have you been fulfilling your duty in praying for other Believers and Unbelievers? Have you been walking wisely toward Believers and especially Unbelievers?
- **B.** Does the way you live and the words you say point Unbelievers to Christ? If not, ask God for wisdom and strength to change.
