#### **Introduction:**

Eternal Life is the Gift of God to those who Believe in Jesus Christ. It begins when a person puts his faith in Jesus Christ. It is everlasting – It continues throughout eternity.

- **Hope** expectation, trust, confidence, anticipation of something good, looking forward to something.
- A. The Certainty of Eternal Life
- B. Eternal Life is a Present Possession
- C. Eternal Life is a Future Possession
- ❖ Enjoy Jesus in this life and look forward to being with Him in the life to come That's Eternal Life.

#### **II.** The Promise of Eternal Life (v. 2b)

- o **Promise** to proclaim, to promise, profess, making a claim
- A. Eternal Life is a Promise by God Himself
- B. God Promised Eternal Life Before the World Began
- **C.** God is True to His Word (Promise)

# **III.** The Message of Eternal Life (v. 3)

 Message – a proclamation, preaching, the preaching of the Gospel – Jesus' life, death, and resurrection.

### The Bible Presents a Clear Path to Eternal Life (Romans Road):

- **A.** Admit that we have sinned against God done things displeasing to God and deserving of punishment (Rom 3:10, 23; 6:23)
- **B.** Believe that Jesus demonstrated His love for us and died to pay our sin debt (Rom 5:8).
- C. Confession of our sin (Rom 10:9, 13)
  Faith alone in the finished work of Christ on the Cross is the only true path to Eternal Life. Salvation is in Jesus Christ alone.

### **Conclusion:**

- **A.** Eternal Life is the Believer's Hope, the Believer's Promise, and the Believer's Message. Trust God at His Word He is always true, loving, and faithful to His Word.
- B. "<sup>3</sup> For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; <sup>4</sup> And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures" (1 Cor 15:3-4).
