Introduction:

As we show our Thankfulness to God, continue to read, study, and meditate on the following Bible Verses:

I. Thank God for our Salvation

- "The Lord is my strength and song and is become my salvation" (Ps 118:14).
- "I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation" (Ps 118:21).

II. Thank God for His Righteousness

• "I will praise the Lord according to his righteousness: and will sing praise to the name of the Lord most high" (Ps 7:7).

III. Thank God for His Goodness

- "Praise ye the Lord. O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever" (Ps 106:1).
- "O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever" (Ps 136:1).

IV. Thank God for Wisdom

• "I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and might, and hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast now made known unto us the king's matter" (Dan 2:23).

V. Thank God Before Meals

- "³⁶ And he took the seven loaves and the fishes, and gave thanks, and brake them, and gave to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude. ³⁷ And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the broken meat that was left seven baskets full (Matt 15:36-37).
- "And when he had thus spoken, he took bread, and gave thanks to God in presence of them all: and when he had broken it, he began to eat" (Acts 27:35).

• "And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me" (Luke 22:19).

VI. Thank God for His Wonderful Works (Deeds)

- "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits" (Ps 103:2).

VII. Thank God for His Faithfulness

"²¹ This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope. ²² It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. ²³ They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness. ²⁴ The Lord is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in him (Lam 3:21-24).

VIII. Thank God for the Word of God

- "¹¹ Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee. ¹² Blessed art thou, O Lord: teach me thy statutes" (Ps 119:11-12).
- \circ "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path" (Ps 119:105).
- "The words of the Lord are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times" (Ps 12:6).

IX. Thank God for His Unspeakable (Indescribable) Gift

 \circ "Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift" (2 Cor 9:15).

X. Thank God for Christian Believers

- "And from thence, when the brethren heard of us, they came to meet us as far as Appii forum, and The three taverns: whom when Paul saw, he thanked God, and took courage" (Acts 28:15).
- "¹⁵ And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful. ¹⁶ Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. ¹⁷ And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him (Col 3:15-17).
