Introduction:

Isaiah 9:6 – "For unto us a child is born, unto us a Son is given" is a prophecy of the Birth of Christ, the Wonderful Savior.

I. Christ is Wonderful in His Pre-Existence

The pre-existence of Christ means that, before He became a man and walked on the earth, He was already in existence as the second Person of the Trinity (Father, **Son**, Holy Ghost).

- A. Christ's pre-existence is proclaimed in the prayer of Moses.
- B. Christ's pre-existence was proclaimed by John the Baptist.
- C. Christ Himself proclaimed His pre-existence.
- D. Christ claimed that He existed prior to Abraham's birth.

II. Christ is Wonderful in His Virgin Birth

- A. Christ was born of a virgin
- B. Jesus is the only Person to be born of a virgin
- C. Jesus is in a class by Himself born of a virgin.

III. Christ is Wonderful in His Sinless Life

- **A. Jesus was born fully human**. However, He was not born in sin Jesus had a sinless nature.
- **B.** Jesus was born of one earthly parent (The Virgin Mary) so that He could share in our humanity.
- C. Jesus was tempted in every way just as we are, However, He never committed a sin.

Conclusion:

A. As you celebrate Christmas, remember our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Without Jesus, we have no Christmas. Without Jesus, we have no eternal life. Without Jesus, we have no abundant life.
