PALM SUNDAY: THE KING IS COMING Matthew 21:1-11

INTRODUCTION:

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week (also known as Passion Week) – the last week of our Lord's life. The day marked a time of celebration where Jesus was worshipped and praised. Holy Week is the time from Palm Sunday through Easter Sunday (Resurrection Sunday).

- Jesus willingly went to the Cross suffered and died in order to pay for the sins of His people.
- I. The Last Week of Christ's Life (v. 1a)
 - A. The small village of Bethpage was a suburb of Jerusalem, lying toward the Mount of Olives.
 - B. This was the only time in Christ's ministry that He actually planned and promoted a public demonstration.
- **II. Jesus Intentionally Fulfilled Prophecy** (vv. 1b-5)
 - A. Christ sent two disciples on a mission (v. 1b)
 - B. Jesus fulfilled prophecy be riding a borrowed colt into Jerusalem (vv. 4-5; Zech 9:9)
- III. <u>Jesus Intentionally Received the Recognition of the Disciples</u> (vv. 6-7)
 - A. The Disciples Paid Recognition to Christ
 - **B.** Thoughts to Ponder
- IV. Jesus Intentionally Received the Recognition of the People (vv. 8-9)
 - A. "A very great multitude" showed up to praise and recognize Jesus.
 - B. The multitude received Christ as the Messiah

CONCLUSION:

A. The Question of the People in Jerusalem

Question: "Who is this?" (v. 10)

Answer: "This is Jesus the Prophet of Nazareth of Galilee."

B. Personal Question for Everyone

Question: Who is Jesus to you? What are you going to do about Jesus? Who do you say Jesus is?

Answer: Accept or reject Christ as the Savior. Peter proclaimed Jesus as "The Christ, the son of the Living God" (Matt 16:16).
