- **III.** <u>The Confirmation of the Gospel</u> (vv. 5-11) There were eyewitnesses to the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

- **A.** The Resurrection of Jesus Christ is a Fact (Truth, Reality). According to the Scriptures, "Christ died for our sin … He was buried and that He rose again the third day" (vv. 3-4).
