Introduction:

- A. **Jesus stood in the Gap – He Died for us, Stood in the Gap, Intercessor, Go Between**
- B. **Jesus Saved Us from Hell**
- C. **Jesus did not solely die on the Cross – He died for You.**
- D. **Alas, and did my Savior bleed**

II. Our Father's Love is Inseparable (Rom 8:35-39)

There is nothing in the universe that can separate the Believer from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- A. **Not Death**
- B. **Not Life**
- C. **Not Angels. Principalities or Powers**
- D. **Not Anything Present or Anything to Come**
- E. **Not Height or Depth**
- F. **Not Any Other Creature**

III. Our Father's Love is Unconditional (Malachi 3:6; Heb 13:8).

Unconditional Love means choosing to love regardless of circumstances.

- A. **God's love does not change.**
- B. **We cannot do anything that will make our Heavenly Father love us more or love us less.**
- C. **Jesus Has No Conditions on His Love**

IV. Our Father's Love Will Show in Areas of Our Lives

- A. **There will be love for the Savior** (John 14:15).
- B. **There will be love for the Scriptures** (2 Tim 2:15).
- C. **There will be love for the Church** (Heb 10:25).
- D. **There will be love for other Believers** (1 John 4:20-21).
- E. **There will be love for Unbelievers** (Rom 6:23).
