- I. Believers Should Exhibit a Selfless Attitude (v. 6)
 - **A. Jesus, the Son of God, is God in the flesh** (John 10:30, John 8:58)
 - **B.** Jesus was Selfless (Heb 12:2)
 - C. Believers are to be Selfless Just like Jesus
- **II.** Believers Should Exhibit a Servant-Centered Attitude (v. 7b)
 - A. Jesus carried out the will of God the Father (John 3:17, 4:34, 6:38)
 - **B. Jesus as Servant** (Luke 19:10; Mark 10:45)
 - C. Believers are to be servants just like Jesus
- III. Believers Should Exhibit a Humble Attitude (v. 8b)
 - **A.** Jesus was Humble (v. 7)
 - B. Christ did not seek wealth, fame noticed reward here of earth
- IV. Believers Should Exhibit an Obedient Attitude (v. 8b)
 - A. Christ was "obedient unto death" (2 Cor 5:21; 1 Pet 2:24)
 - **B.** Believers are to have an obedient attitude just like Jesus (Acts 5:29; James 4:7)
 - C. Obeying God Rather Than Man
