LABORERS IN THE VINEYARD Matthew 20:1-16

INTRODUCTION:

In this parable <u>God</u> is the householder, <u>Believers</u> are the laborers, and the <u>Vineyard</u> is the world or the church. There is a great need for God's people to Work in the Vineyard to reach the Unsaved today and every day. Working for God is a privilege and great responsibility for every Christian Believer.

- I. <u>The Lord's Vineyard is Exceedingly Large</u> (vv. 1, 3, 5, 6)
