INTRODUCTION:

God proved His love on the Cross. When Christ hung, and bled, and died, it was God saying to the world, "I Love You" (Billy Graham).

o "Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God (1 John 4:7).

 - C. Christians have the Love for the Savior (John 14:15; Rev 2:4)
 - **D.** Christians have a Love for the Scriptures (John 5:39; Acts 17:11)
 - E. Christians have a Love for the Church (Heb 10:25)
 - **F.** Christians have a Love for the Saints (1 John 4:20-21) and for Unbelievers.
