WALKING WITH GOD (PART II) 1 John 2:1-6

INTRODUCTION:

Following God's precepts keep us from sin because they are founded in God's truth. "The Bible will keep you from sin or sin will keep you from the Bible." – D. L. Moody

• "He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked." (1 John 2:6).

Last week, we studied three ways as to how Believers are to walk with God: (1) Walk Honestly, (2) Walk in the Spirit, and (3) Walk in Love.

Today, we will examine three additional ways as to how Believers are to Walk with God:

- I. Walk Circumspectly (Eph 5:15)
 - A. The Foolish or Unwise Person (v. 15a)
 - **B.** The Wise Person (v. 15b; 1 John 1:7)
- II. Walk in Faith (Col 2:6)
 - A. Accepting Christ as the Savior of your life is the beginning of life with Christ.
 - **B. Faith is the belief in something that is unseen** (Heb 11:1; 2 Tim 3:16; 1 John 2:2; 4:14; 1 Thess 1:10; Titus 2:13)
- **III.** Walk in Wisdom, Redeeming the Time (Col 4:5; Titus 2:12)
 - A. Believers are to walk in wisdom toward those who are without Christ.
 - B. Believers are to redeem the time toward those who are without Christ

CONCLUSION:

- A. Believers are to: (1) Walk Circumspectly, (2) Walk in Faith, and (3) Walk in Wisdom, Redeeming the Time.
- B. Spend time walking with God daily to grow in your Christian life Christianity is enjoying a relationship with God through Christ.
