

PRAISE THE LORD!
Psalm 113:1-9

INTRODUCTION:

Praise the Lord means that we Rejoice and Give Thanks to God for all He has done for us. We Praise the Lord because He is Worthy of all our Praise.

In this message, we will examine five aspects (questions) related to Praising the Lord:

- I. WHO SHOULD PRAISE THE LORD? (v. 1)**
 - A. God’s servants are the children of God – those who have been Born Again**
 - B. Characteristics of God’s Servants (John 12:26; Eph 4:2-3; 1 Pet 4:10)**

- II. HOW TO PRAISE THE LORD? (vv. 1b – 2a)**
 - A. “Praise the Name of the Lord” (v. 1b; Ps 90:2; Mal 3:6; Titus 1:2; Deut 32:4; John 3:16)**
 - B. Bless the Name of the Lord (v. 2a; Ps 136:1; 145:3)**

- III. WHEN SHOULD WE PRAISE THE LORD? (v. 2b)**
 - A. Christians are Commanded to Praise the Name of the Lord Continually**
 - B. The Lord is Worthy of our Praise at All Times (Ps 34:1; 106:1)**
 - C. Praising God in the Midst of Trials**

- IV. WHERE SHOULD WE PRAISE THE LORD? (v. 3)**
 - A. Christians are to Praise the Lord from everywhere – East to West**
 - B. Christians are Commanded to Praise God’s Holy Name at All Times**
 - C. Praise Him in the Morning**

- V. WHY SHOULD WE PRAISE THE LORD? (vv. 4-9)**
 - A. God is Worthy of Our Praise (v. 4; 1 Chron 29:11-13)**
 - B. God is Incomparable – Set Apart from all Else – He Rules on High (v. 5; Exod 15:11; Isa 40:18; Deut 3:24)**
 - C. God Inspires Our Praise (vv. 6-9; Rom 5:8;)**

- VI. CONCLUSION:**
 - A. God wants us to Praise Him. You should never run out of reasons to Praise God.**
 - B. Praise God for Salvation – which is in Christ Alone (Acts 4:12; Isa 45:22)**
 - C. Romans Road ((Rom 3:10, 23; 5:8; 10:9, 13)**
