WHO DO YOU SAY JESUS IS? (Mark 8:27-30)

INTRODUCTION:

Who do you say Jesus is? A person's eternal destiny is tied to his/her answer to this question – Do you claim Jesus as your Savior?

• "And he saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? And Peter answereth and saith unto him, Thou art the Christ" (Mark 8:29).

In this message, we will examine three Biblical Names and Titles for who Jesus is.

- I. JESUS IS THE SAVIOR (John 1:29; 4:42; 1 Tim 1:15; 1 John 4:14)
 - **A.** As humans, we have sinned against God and separated ourselves from the God (Rom 3:23; 6:23; Matt 25:33, 34, 41, 46)
 - B. God sent Jesus to rescue mankind from their sins (John 3:16).
 - **C. Jesus paid for our sin debt in full by dying on the Cross** (1 Pet 2:24; 1 John 2:2)
 - **D.** Jesus is the only means by which we can have our sins forgiven and Heaven is our home (John 14:16; Acts 4:12).

II. <u>JESUS IS THE MAKER OF HEAVEN AND EARTH</u> (Gen 1:1-25; Ps 33:6; 89:11; 146:6; Isa 40:28)

- A. All three persons of the Trinity were involved in the creation of the universe (Gen 1:1-2; John 1:1-3, 18; Acts 17:24; Heb 1:2; John 8:57-58; 10:30).
- B. God is not a created being.
- C. God has always existed and will always exist (Ps 90:2; 102:24-25, 27).
- III. JESUS IS THE SON OF GOD (Ps 2:7; Matt 3:17; 17:5; Mark 1:11; Heb 1:5)
 - A. Jesus as the Son of God means that He is God made manifest in human flesh.
 - **B.** Jesus as the Son of God means that He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, who is God (Luke 1:35).
 - **C.** Jesus as the Son of God possesses the same attributes as God and both co-equal (John 5:21-23).
 - **D.** Biblical passages indicating that Jesus is the Son of God (Matt 4:1-3; 8:28-29; 14:32-33; Mark 15:39; Luke 1:35; Rom1:14; Gal 2:20; Matt 26:63-64; John 5:25; 1 John 3:8; 4:15; 5:5, 10, 12, 13, 20).
 - E. Jesus Christ is the Son of God the Father (2 John 3)
