(Matt 16:13-18)

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

The church is a called-out people. The church is a who, not a what. It is a living organism Jesus Christ is the Head of the Church. The church is not a building, it is a Body of Believers, it is not a business, it is the Bride of Christ, chosen by the Father.

- o "15 He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? 16 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matt 16:15-16).
- I. The Church is Described as "The Whole Family in Heaven and Earth" (Eph 3:15)
  - A. The family of God consist of the Triune God Father, Son and Holy Spirit (Ps 90:2; Heb 2:10).
  - B. The family of God consist of all the Believers in Heaven and on Earth past, present and in the future (Rom 8:16-17; 1 John 3:1-2; Gal 3:26).
  - C. The family of God consist of Angels (Matt 16:27; Luke 4:10; Rev 8:2).
- II. The Church is Described as "Children of Light" (Eph 5:8)
  - **A. The walk of "Darkness"** (v. 8a; Gal 5:19-21; 1 John 1:5-6)
  - **B.** The walk of "Light" (v. 8b; Eph 5:9-10; Gal 5:22-23, 25)
  - C. Believers through union with Christ have become light Believers are in Him –
  - D. Believers should have no fellowship with the unfruitful work of darkness
- III. The Church is Described as "A Glorious Church" (Eph 5:27)
  - A. Glorious means held in honor, highly esteemed, splendid, distinguished, honorable, being bright.
  - B. In time past, Christ's love was revealed in the Believer's redemption. In the present, it's seen in our sanctification. In the future, it will be exhibited in our glorification.
  - C. Jesus Christ Himself will present the church (Body of Believers) to himself a glorious church "not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be Holy and without blemish."
  - D. Christ loved the church and gave Himself for it.
- IV. The Church is Described as "My Brethren" (Eph 6:10, 23)
  - A. When Paul used the term "My Brethren," He is referring to Believers in Christ Jesus The Church.
  - **B.** As Paul is closing this letter "Finally" (v. 10).
  - **C. Paul's charge to Believers experiencing spiritual warfare** (v 10b-c; Luke 1:37; Eph 3:16; 2 Tim 1:7)
  - **D.** Believers are to make use of "The Whole Armor of God" during spiritual warfare (v. 11, 13-18).
- V. The Church is Described as "Them that Love our Lord Jesus Christ in Sincerity" (Eph 6:24; Matt 22:37-38)

#### **CONCLUSION:**

A. The church is described as: "The Whole Family in Heaven and Earth," "Children of Light," "A Glorious Church," "My Brethren," and "Them that Love our Lord Jesus Christ in Sincerity"
