

“THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST”
(Romans 1:16-17)

INTRODUCTION:

Today’s subject – “The Gospel of Christ – is taken from verse 16 of our text. It is a clear declaration of God’s Power to save all who believe in Christ regardless of their race, nationality or condition.

- **“For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek” (Rom 1:16).**

In this message, we will study three views of “The Gospel of Christ”:

- I. THE DEFINITION OF THE GOSPEL (v. 16b)**
 - A. The Gospel of Christ is the Good News of Peace with God, through the Blood of His Son Jesus Christ.**
 - B. The word Gospel comes from a Greek word (Euangelion), which means Good News.**
 - C. The Gospel embraces the life, death and resurrection of Christ as the Savior of the world (1 Cor 15:3-4).**

 - E. There is Only One True Gospel – The Gospel of Jesus Christ (Gal 1:6-9; Eph 2:8-9)**

- II. THE ESTIMATION OF THE GOSPEL (v. 16a)**
 - A. “Ashamed” means guilt, shame, distressed, embarrassed, disgraceful or feeling of guilt for wrongdoing (sin).**
 - B. Paul was not ashamed to Believe The Gospel (Acts 9:6)**
 - C. Paul was Not Ashamed to Confess the Gospel (Rom 1:15; 1 Cor 2:2; Matt 10:32; Rom 10:9-10)**
 - D. Paul was not Ashamed to Suffer for The Gospel (Acts 9:15-16; 16:23-24; 17:10, 13-14; 17:32; 14:19; 2 Cor 11:23-28; 2 Tim 3:12)**

- III. THE POWER OF THE GOSPEL (v. 16c)**
 - A. The Gospel is the Power of God (John 3:16; 1 John 4:10, 14; Matt 1:21; John 3:17; 1 Thess 5:9-10; 2 Tim 4:18)**
 - B. The Gospel of the Power of God unto Salvation to Everyone that Believeth (Rom 5:8; Acts 16:30-31)**
