Paul was a faithful witness both in the life that he lived and the message that he preached (Acts 20:18-21). We are to be sincere when sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ with others – It is a matter of life or death.

- D. God Provided His Son as the Sacrifice for Our Sins Past, Present and Future

III. THE RECEPTION OF GRACE

- A. To Receive God's Saving Grace Requires Obedience (Heb 5:9; Rom 10:9-10; Acts 17:30)
- B. Jesus is the Source of Eternal Salvation to all who Obey Him Obedience is Not Earning or Meriting Salvation (Eph 2:8-9; Titus 3:5)
