FOR WHOM DID JESUS DIE? (John 3:15-17)

INTRODUCTION:

This message is based on a previous Bible Study:

A. Jesus is the Only Way to Heaven (Luke 19:10; 1 Tim 1:15)

John Dyer, a Welsh poet and pastor from the 1700s once wrote, "A man may go to Heaven without health, without riches, without honors, without learning, without friends; but he can never go there without Christ." Today our world is filled with people who are seeking some other way to God than the one found in the blood of Jesus and His precious name, but all such efforts are doomed to failure. Jesus is the only Way to Heaven. (Ministry 127).

B. Who is the Remedy for Sin? (Heb 9:22; Rom 3:24-25; John 14:6))

For Whom Did Jesus Die? "What saith the Scriptures?" (Rom 4:3).

- I. JESUS DIED FOR "ALL" (1 Tim 2:6)
 - A. Jesus Gave Himself a Ransom for ALL
 - B. The Ransom Paid by Jesus' Death is Available to ALL (Matt 20:28; Eph 1:7).
- II. <u>JESUS DIED FOR "ALL MEN"</u> (Rom 5:18; 1 Tim 4:10)
 - A. In Romans 5:18, the first "all men" refers to all who are in Adam, and the second "all men" refers to All who are in Christ Jesus (Rom 1:17; 5:1; 1 Cor 6:11).
 - **B.** "Who is the Savior of All Men" Christ Jesus specially of those that believe (1 Tim 4:10).
- III. <u>JESUS DIED FOR "US ALL"</u> (Isa 53:6)
 - A. "All We" All, Everybody, Anybody, Mankind
 - **B.** "The Iniquity of Us All" (Isa 53:4,5, 6, 8, 9, 12).
 - C. In Isaiah 53, the ancient Prophet Isaiah described the suffering that Christ endured for mankind "Us All." (1 Pet 2:24-25; John 10:10)

CONCLUSION:

- A. For Whom Did Jesus Die? He died for "ALL, "ALL MEN," and "US ALL."
- B. "We ought to be living as if Jesus died yesterday, rose this morning, and is coming back this afternoon." Pastor Adrian Rogers

 - o $\mathbf{B} \underline{\mathbf{Believe}}$ that Jesus died on the Cross and rose again for your sins (Rom 5:8, 1 Cor. 15:3-4).
 - o C Confess/Call on Jesus Christ as your personal Lord and Savior (Rom 10:9-13)
