CHRIST AND THE LAW Matthew 5:17-20

INTRODUCTION:

In this message, Christ And The Law, we will survey Christ's fulfillment of The Law and His call to True Righteousness.

• "Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil (Matt 5:17).

I. <u>CHRIST'S FULFILLMENT OF THE LAW AND THE PROHETS</u> (v. 17)

- A. Jesus' Declaration
- **B.** Ways in Which Christ Fulfilled The Law (Heb 4:15; 2 Cor 5:21; Gal 3:13; 1 John 1:7; Rev 1:5)
- **C. Christ Fulfilled Old Testament Prophecies** (Isa 7:14; Matt 1:23; Gen 22:8; John 1:29; Ps 23:1; John 10:11; Luke 24:25-27)
- **D.** Christ Fulfilled The Law by Revealing the True Meaning of The Law (Rom 3:20)

II. <u>CHRIST AFFIRMS THE AUTHORITY OF SCRIPTURE</u> (vv. 18-19)

- A. According to Christ not one jot or one <u>tittle</u> would pass from The Law until all is completely fulfilled (v. 18; Matt 5:18; 2 Tim 3:16; John 10:35).
- **B.** The Word of God Stands Forever (Isa 40:8)
- C. We Must Practice and Teach the Whole Bible (v. 19; Acts 20:26-27)
- **D.** Jesus warned all who break the law, even if it is the least, shall be called the least in the Kingdom of Heaven (v. 19a).
- **E.** The obedient person can expect great reward. He shall be called great in Heaven (v. 19b; John 14:15; 1 Pet 1:14-16).

III. <u>CHRIST'S PROCLAMATION FOR GODLY RIGHTEOUSNESS</u> (v. 20; Matt 23)

- A. Their Righteousness Was Self-Servicing (vv. 5-7, 20b)
- **B.** We must have Godly righteousness to enter the Kingdom of Heaven (20a; Rom 3:21; Isa 51:5, 6, 8; 56:1; Phil 3:9; Rom 8:4; Matt 22:37-39)

CONCLUSION:

- A. Jesus came to fulfill The Law and The Prophet, to affirm the authority of Scripture and to proclaim the need for Godly righteousness.
- **B.** Christ's is the Believer's righteousness. Christ is the righteousness that exceeds the righteousness of the Scribes and Pharisees.
- C. "O taste and see that the Lord is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him" (Ps 34:8).
