OVERCOME EVIL WITH GOOD

(Matthew 5:38-42)

INTRODUCTION:

Today, we will study: Overcome Evil With Good - In this message, Jesus is teaching that Christians are to respond to evilness with kindness and love, rather than with retaliation – not returning evil for evil.

• "Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men" (Rom 12:17).

In this message, we will study three points related to our subject – "Overcome Evil With Good:"

- I. THE TEACHING OF THE SCRIBES AND PHARISEES ON RETALIATION (v. 38)
 - A. "Ye have heard that it hath been said..." (Exod 21:24-25; Lev 24:20; Deut 19:21;
 - B. The Scribes and Pharisees took the law out of context.
 - C. Based on this law, the principle of punishment consisted of two basic purposes (Deut 19:20; Gen 4:23-24)
- II. THE TEACHING OF JESUS ON RESISTING RETALIATION (vv. 39-41)
 - A. Jesus said, "But I say unto you ..." (v. 39a)
 - B. Christ is not saying "Resist not Evil" ever (v. 39b; Matt 21:12-13; Gal 1:6-10)
 - C. Christ is Saying "Resist Not Evil" (Rom 12:17; 1 Thess 5:15; 1 Pet 3:9)
 - D. The Danger of Revenge/Retaliation
 - E. Christ shared four illustrations that teach Christians how to treat those who have mistreated them (1 Cor 13:7; Eph 4:2; Matt 5:25; Gal 6:2; Acts 20:35).

III. CHRISTIAN STANDARDS FOR INTERPERSONAL ACTIONS

- A. Value others above yourself.
- B. Treat others, including your enemies with love, respect and kindness.
- C. God above and beyond what is requested of you.
- D. Loving God and others is more important than personal rights and property.
- E. Do not retaliate or seek revenge.

CONCLUSION:

- A. The Right Ambition (Col 3:17)
- B. "And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you" (Eph 4:32).
- C. Always trust in the Lord You can trust Him in whatever adversity or calamity that you may experience (1 Pet 2:23).
- **D.** We can trust God with the results as He is good (Rom 12:19)
- E. Romans Road (Rom 3:10, 23; 5:8; 10:9, 13)
