### CHARACTERISTICS OF A GODLY MOTHER Proverbs 31:10-31

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

On May 19, 1914, by an act of Congress, President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day. He established the day as a time of "public expression of our love and reverence for the mothers of our country."

o "Favour is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that feareth the Lord, she shall be praised" (Prov 31:30).

- **A.** Her husband has full confidence in her (v. 12)

- **B.** She takes care of the family's food (v. 14, 15)
- C. She uses her head (vv. 16-19)

### III. SHE IS GENEROUS (v. 20)

- **A.** She provides for the poor and needy
- **B.** She is concerned about her family and others (Ps 41:1; Prov 14:31)
- **C.** Her true love is shown in deed and truth (1 John 3:16-18)

#### IV. SHE IS READY FOR TOUGH TIMES (v. 21-22; 25)

- **A.** She is not anxious
- **B.** She plans ahead and trusts in God

#### V. SHE IS A TEACHER OF WISDOM (v. 26)

- **A.** She teaches her children what is right (Prov 1:8; Eph 6:1-2)
- **B.** She is a positive influence to her husband
- C. Her words are of wisdom (James 1:5; James 4:2)

#### VI. SHE IS WORTHY OF PRAISE (vv. 28-29; 31)

- A. Her children "call her blessed" (v. 28)
- **B.** "Her husband ... praiseth her" (v. 28)
- C. Give her the reward she has earned and let her works bring praise (v. 31)

## VII. SHE FEARS THE LORD (v. 30)

- **A.** She is committed to the Lord
- **B.** She is devoted to pleasing God (1 Pet 3:3-4; Prov 1:7; 4:23; 8:13; 9:10)
