III. <u>THE TWO MASTERS</u> (v. 24)

- A. The Two Masters are "God and Mammon"
- B. Jesus said, a person cannot serve God and Mammon at the same time.
- C. Choose to serve God Make Him your Master (Matt 6:33).
- **D.** To serve God and Mammon is an impossible task (Matt 27:3-5; Acts 5:1-5)
- You must separate yourself from the fellowship of the world, or the world will separate you from the fellowship of God.
