INTRODUCTION:

Today, we will begin our study on the last Chapter of the Sermon On The Mount. In this message we will study – Judging Others.

o "⁴ Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment" (John 7:24).

- D. Do Not Judge Others With A Self-Righteous Spirit (Luke 18:9-14; Eph 4:29)

III. THE SOLUTION: SELF-EXAMINATION AND REPENTANCE (vv. 5b-6)

- **A. Hold Introspection** (v. 5)
- **B.** Introspection before par-taking Communion (1 Cor 11:28, 31-32)
- C. We Are To Judge Righteously (John 7:24; Jer 17:9)
- **D.** Avoid making judgments based on half-truths, hear-say, or rumors (James 1:19-20)
- E. <u>Use Constructive Criticism</u> <u>T-H-I-N-K Before You Speak</u> T – Is it TRUE? - H – Is it HELPFUL? - I – Is it INSPIRING? N – Is it NECESSARY? - K – Is it KIND?
