 - 1. James uses this illustration to teach the folly of trusting in material possessions (James 1:10-11).
 - 2. Paul used this illustration to teach the passing nature of everything related to humanity (1 Pet 1:24-25; Heb 13:8).

 - 1. Source of Truth (Gen 1:27; Gen 5:2; Gen 1:1; Ps 124:8; Isa 45:18)
 - 2. Attributes of God
 - o God is Eternal (Ps 90:2), God is Immutable (Ps 102:26-27; Mal 3:6), God is Omnipotent (Jer 32:17, 27), God is Omnipresent (Ps 139:7-13), God is Omniscient (Ps 139:1-5).

 - O God's Word Directs our Steps (Ps 119:133); God's Word Illuminates Our Path (Ps 119:105); and God's Word Makes us Wise (Ps 119:30)

- **D.** God Promised us a New Home Heaven (John 14:1-3)


III. <u>LIVING IN LIGHT OF GOD'S EVERLASTING WORD</u> (Titus 2:11-15)
