## GOD'S AMAZING LOVE Romans 5:6-11

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

God's Amazing Love for mankind is so great that He sent His Son Jesus Christ to die for sins, making it possible for anyone to be forgiven through faith, regardless of their past actions.

• "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (Rom 5:8).

In this message, we will meditate on three declarations related to God's Amazing Love:

- I. THE HOPELESS CONDITION OF MANKIND (vv. 6, 8-10)
  - A. Mankind is in a hopeless condition because of complete spiritual powerlessness and ungodliness.
  - B. A person is in a hopeless condition without Christ and is considered to be separated from God, and lacking spiritual life.
  - C. Who We Were Before Christ (Before Salvation) (Eph 2:12; 1 Thess 4:13; Rom 3:10-12; Rom 3:23; James 4:4)

• "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him" (2 Cor 5:21).

- o C Confess/Call on Jesus Christ as your personal Lord and Savior (Rom 10:9-13)
