

# LOVING GOD AND LOVING OTHERS

Mark 12:28-34

(Gospel Parallel: Matt 22:33-40)

## INTRODUCTION:

### **A. This Text Summarizes Jesus Identifying The Two Greatest Commandments.**

**Loving God Supremely** (heart, soul, mind, strength), **and Loving Your Neighbor as Yourself**. Jesus declares that these two commandments covers all the law, which a scribe recognized, leading Jesus to say to him, “Thou art not far from the Kingdom of God” (v. 34).

- “<sup>30</sup> And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. <sup>31</sup> And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these (Mark 12:30-31).
