### **INTRODUCTION:**

**To Trust In The Lord means to believe His Word and obey Him. Trusting Jesus means committing ourselves entirely to Him.**

- “<sup>5</sup>Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. <sup>6</sup>In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths” (Prov 3:5-6).

- C. God is Immutable** (Mal 3:6; Heb 13:8)
- D. God Fulfils His Plans and Purposes** (Jer 29:11; Ps 138:8; Eph 2:10; Ps 34:1)
- E. God is Sovereign** (Ps 24:1, 89:11)
  - **God is in control of His Universe.**  
**He is Omnipotent:** All-Powerful (Job 42:2; John 19:11)  
**He is Omniscient:** All-Knowing (Isa 46:10; Ps 139:1-3; 1 John 3:20; Matt 10:29-30)  
**He is Omnipresent:** All-Present (Ps 33:13-14; Isa 40:12).  
**He is Omnibenevolent:** All Good (Mark 10:18)
