

OUR GREAT SALVATION

1 Peter 1:10-12

INTRODUCTION:

Jesus died to Save us from our sin. There is no other means of Salvation. A person must come to Christ for eternal life.

- **How shall we escape, if we neglect *so great salvation*; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him (Heb 2:3).**

In this message, we will meditate on four (4) factors of Our Great Salvation:

 - A. Concerning This Salvation (10a; Eph 1:4; Titus 1:2)**

 - E. Christ Fulfilled the Prophecy of the Old Testament Prophets**

- II. THE SPIRIT-LED REVELATION (vv. 11b – 12a)**
 - A. The Suffering Messiah (v. 11b; Isa 53; Ps 22; Zech 12:10)**
 - B. The Subsequent Glories of the Messiah (v. 11c; Rev 1:18; 1 Pet 3:22; 2 Pet 1:11)**

- III. THE PROCLAMATION OF THE GOSPEL (v. 12b)**
 - A. The Old Testament Prophets Spoke of the Coming Savior and Salvation**
 - B. The Message of Christ's Death and Resurrection**
 - C. Preachers of this Age Must Preach the Same Gospel Message – Jesus Saves!**

- IV. THE ANGELIC AWE (v. 12c)**
 - A. Salvation is so glorious that it arouses the Angels to look into it.**
 - B. Angels are not able to experience Salvation, as they are of the Spiritual World (Heavenly Beings).**
 - C. Angels are fascinated by God's Plan of Salvation for Mankind.**
 - D. The Angels watch in wonder as God saves His people from their sin.**
 - E. The Angels are thankful for your Salvation (Luke 15:10).**
