

PARTAKERS OF THE LORD'S TABLE
1 Corinthians 10:16-23

INTRODUCTION:

We partake of the Lord's Table (Holy Communion or Lord's Supper) on the first Sunday of the month. Only born-again Believers should partake in Communion – It is for Christians only. According to the Apostle Paul, in verse 21, It is inconsistent for a Believer to partake in the Table of the Lord and the table of Devils.

- **“Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils” (1 Cor 10:21).**

In this message, we will meditate on the realities that occur as we Partake of the Lord's Table:

- I. WE SHARE IN THE BLOOD OF CHRIST (v. 21)**
 - A. Believers Have Victory Over Sin** (Rom 3:10, 23, 24-26; Eph 1:7; Col 1:14)
 - B. Believers Have Victory Over Guilt** (Heb 10:22; 1 John 1:9; Eph 2:13)
 - C. Believers have Victory over the Devil** (Rev 12:10; 1 John 2:5-16; 1 John 1:7; 1 John 1:7; Rom 8:31; 1 John 2:1-2; Col 2:13-14)

- II. WE SHARE IN THE BODY OF CHRIST (v. 17)**

Partaking at the Lord's Table means there is to be a oneness in the Body of Christ.

 - A. There is “One Bread”** (v. 17a)
 - B. There is “One Body”** (v. 17b; 1 Cor 12:27)
 - C. “We are all Partakers of that One Bread”** (v. 17c; Isa 53:5; John 1:29; John 6:33; John 6:50)
