

SERMON SERIES: MARKAN SANDWICHES

TWO HEALINGS, ONE SAVIOR

Mark 5:21-43

(Parallel Passages: Matthew 9:18-26; Luke 8:40-56)

INTRODUCTION:

Today, we will study: **Two Healings, One Savior**

In this Markan Sandwich, we will review the healing of the bleeding woman, inside the story of Jairus' daughter. Christ healed a young girl and an ill woman.

- " And he said unto her, **Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague**" (Mark 5:34)

In this message, we will meditate on three (3) facets of **Two Healings, One Savior**:

- I. **THE CRISIS OF DESPERATION** (vv. 21-24) – The Outer Bread – Start
 - A. **The Position Abandoned** (v. 22; Luke 8:42)
 - B. **The Urgent Need** (v. 23)
 - C. **The Prompt Response** (v. 24)
- II. **THE INTERRUPTION OF ISOLATION** (vv. 25-34) – The Middle (Meat) Story
 - A. **The Chronic Suffering of the Woman** (vv. 25-26; Lev 15:25-27)
 - B. **The Hidden Touch of Faith** (vv. 27-29; Luke 8:44)
 - C. **The Public Recognition** (vv. 30-34)
- III. **THE VICTORY OVER DEATH** (vv. 35-43) – The Outer Bread – End
 - A. **The Expired Hope** (vv. 35-36)
 - B. **The Atmosphere of Despair** (vv. 37-40; 41-43)
 - C. **The Two Miracles**

CONCLUSION:

- A. **In a single afternoon, Jesus handled two completely different timelines and two completely different crises.** He proved that He is the Savior of the unclean woman in the crowded street, and He is the Savior of the grieving family in the closed room. For the woman, He was a comforting presence who brought an end to twelve years of suffering. For Jairus, He was a sovereign power who stepped in just as twelve years of future life were snatched away. If you feel that your life is an interruption to God, or if you feel like your situation has flat lined and it is simply "too late" for a miracle, look at the Savior in this passage. He is never too busy to hear your hidden cry, and He is never too late to speak life into your dead ends. Trust His timing, hold onto His hand, and do not fear – only Believe.

B. Come To Jesus

Weak and wounded sinner lost and left to die

O, raise your head for Love is passing by

Come to Jesus, Come to Jesus, Come to Jesus and Live
